1. Individual entries only
2. Entry levels: Two categories (A, Beginner, B, Intermediate+), Students may challenge themselves by competing in a higher level, but nobody is permitted to enter in a level lower than the most recent class they have attended.
3. Speech Time: 3-5 minutes
4. Topic: All participants must develop an interesting topic.
5. Speeches must be memorized and performed verbally. Each performance should not exceed a maximum of 5 minutes.
6. Performances will be judged on:
 - Level of Communication with Audience: Did the performance engage the audience actively and succeed in conveying the main message to them?
 - Completeness of Performance: Was the speech well memorized, choreographed and delivered?
 - Fluency: Did the student speak with clarity and accurate intonation?
