Tib.'s Green Tomato Pickle.

One peck tomatoes, one dozen onions sliced, lay in salt one night. Then pour off the water, and add one ounce each of pepper, allspice and cloves, one-fourth pound mustard seed, one pound sugar; cover with vinegar and boil till tender.

Lucy's Cucumber Chow Chow.

To eight quarts chopped cucumbers, add three quarts onions cut fine, and one pint salt. Let all stand in a sieve twelve hours, then press out as much of the brine as possible. Put in a vessel and cover with vinegar, allowing room for it to swell, as it will be shrunk by the salt at first. Then add three tablespoons sweet oil, two tablespoons black pepper, two teaspoons cayenne pepper, stir frequently, and in three weeks it will be fit for use.

Welcome cake

Take a cup & a half of Sugar & half
 a cup of butter together with three
 well beaten eggs, 2 table spoonful
 of cream of tartar and half a tea spoonful

of soda with three small cups of
 flour this with half a cup of milk
 must be mixed with the above &
 baked in a moderate quick oven.

By adding raisins & currants 1 pound
 of each a very good fruit cake can be
 made

Healthly cake

Take ½ pound of butter ½ pound of
 Sugar the same of flour 4 eggs 2 pounds
 of seeds & raisins 1 pound of currants ½
 pound of citron 1 gill of brandy. Spice
 well with nutmeg & ground cloves

Bake slowly three hours. This cake will keep six months. Being for the cake beat the white of two eggs to a froth then stir in two pounds of powdered sugar flavor with a little essence of lemon & spread on with a comb when the cake is cold.
