



# Reporting an Accessibility Barrier

## What is an Accessibility Barrier?

The Office of Equity & Access (OEA) mission is upholding and reaffirming the University's commitment to creating and maintaining workplace, educational and recreational environments that are safe and accessible, and free of all forms of discrimination, including sexual misconduct.

Any physical, structural, or digital infrastructure that prevents students, faculty, and staff from accessing any of Stony Brook's resources, such as classroom, residence halls, dining accommodations, activities, etc., is considered an Accessibility Barrier.
