

Resolutions on Protest and Policing

WHEREAS President McInnis and senior administration have responded to peaceful protests on our campus with a disproportionate degree of force, failing to negotiate with students in good faith and deploying Suffolk County Police and New York States Troopers to arrest members of the Stony Brook community.

BE IT RESOLVED that the University Senate demands an independent investigation, by a committee established by the Senate, into the Enterprise Risk Management unit's handling of student protests and "intelligence-gathering" of staff, faculty, and students; and the development of a shared governance mechanism to oversee its activities.
